Guidelines for the Reception of Communion

The reception of Holy Communion is the most sacred act for Catholics. We believe that we are then receiving the Body and Blood of Christ. Catholics who are properly prepared should approach the ministers of Holy Communion. Non-Catholics are invited to come forward with arms crossed over their heart to receive a blessing.

Those who are able are asked to stand as the priest receives communion, and throughout the communion procession, as a sign of our unity as members of the Body of Christ. Please continue to sing as you move in procession to receive communion. When all have received, and as the ministers move toward the credence table, the assembly is seated for a brief period of silence.
