Roof	Unk.	Metal & roll roofing: granular loss/deterioration indicates end of life; evidence of gutters leaking; no vents / insulation in attic	SHELL — Replacing/repairing the roof & gutters protects the building — do this before tuckpointing

Exterior shell		Deteriorating mortar at rear and on chimney (no chimney rain cap)	SHELL – Tuckpointing protects the building
Interior		Water damaged walls/ceilings at rear	HEALTH & SAFETY – address environmental issues like mold, etc.
